# Kyneton Pony Club Horse Trials



Nic Bertalli, Nikki Grey and Kerryn Gooding made the long trek to compete at Kyneton Pony Club Horse Trials, Sunday 14th November and had a great day over a really challenging course.

Nic and Frisky won Grade 2 Open with a mixed dressage test showing some brilliant moves and some naughty bits, a seamless SJ round, and faultless XC; Nikki and Snip were 2nd in the Grade 2 Pony Club with one of their best ever dressage tests, brilliant SJ round, and an also faultless XC over a difficult course; with Kerryn and Brandy also doing a mixed dressage test, beautiful SJ round, and being ecstatic to get around their first Grade 3 XC course only to realise some time later that they'd totally forgotten to jump one of the jumps.

Nic's daughter Tess also competed in the Grade 4 Pony Club leading after the dressage and placing 3rd with just a few time penalties XC.





Ros Burns with Buddy (Double TT Preview) won the Jackpot at Wangaratta SJ with 1st in Top Score, 1st in Two Phase and 6th in AM7.

Julie King on Runaway Bandit was 2nd in AM7; 2nd in Top Score and were sitting equal 1st in Jackpot but unfortunately knocked a rail in last event being the Two Phase competition which put them back into 6th place, still a great effort for the combination.

Jane Parks on Parkview Imagine was 8th in the A2, 12th in the Top Score and 5th in the Two Phase pulling a rail on the last fence of the final event, however 4<sup>th</sup> in overall Tri Series which was a great result. After completing A2 and the Two Phase on Sand in what was a hot and bothered day, the tired combinations completed the Top Score round on the grass which was a big test.

I didn't even know he could go so well" Ros said. Ros was just hoping Buddy would go clear and not be too upset about any of the jumps and he didn't disappoint, he went so well in the first round Ros thought well "let it rip" for the Top Score and the Two Phase and they did. Buddy turned when Ros asked, really picked up his speed over the course with just a few click clicks and hup hup hups and they were away!!

Ros was thrilled to bits with Buddy as they were up against strong competition and being their first comp at this level Ros is so proud of him and I'm sure we will be featuring many more successes from this competition throughout the year.
