

### New Dressage Tests

New dressage tests for all levels have now been approved and are available on the HRCAV website www.hrcav.com.au for downloading. These tests will be used for all competitions from 1st March 2013 so it would be a good idea to start familiarising yourselves with them now in readiness. They are numbered from .1 to .6 in each level with .1 being the easiest and .6 having a number of moves from the next level up. For example Level 2 tests will range from 2.1 to 2.6. In Level 4 the letters RSVP are now used and there are a number of different movements including leg yielding in the higher levels. The tests provide for a wide range of horse and rider combinations and you won't be out of place riding a pony, welsh cob, clydic cross, thoroughbred, quarter horse, or warmblood. So start practising and come and join us for some fun competitions in 2013.

### DO YOU HAVE A PIC YET? (Horse Property Identification Code)

Properties upon which horses reside now must have Property Identification Codes (PIC) applied for by their owners and allocated by the Department of Primary Industries (DPI). PIC's identify parcels of land and link those with owners and livestock present on that land. The DPI maintains a database of PIC's and contact details of PIC applicants. The information is used to plan for and respond to emergency animal disease events and assists with responses to emergencies such as bushfires.

### Adelaide 3DE

Planes, Horses and Automobiles (we skipped the trains bit). There was a myriad of discussions regarding attending the Adelaide 3DE earlier in the year for any MADEC members.
