Three members of MADEC travelled to Elmore on the 11th & 12th February to compete in the Echuca ARG's Weekend Dressage Championships. Whilst the weather held off raining for us, it was very hot and extremely windy. All horses behaved well despite the windy conditions and we all had a great time together. Echuca held a friendly and well run event with maximum numbers in all levels with over 200 competitors in total over the two days.

Saturday saw Margie, Lauren & Justine compete in their assessed levels riding the B and D tests.

Margie and Ruby rode two great tests, which saw the combination just out of the placings in 3B, but coming 3rd in 3D. It was Lauren's first dressage weekend out with Sir George, and they certainly are an attractive pair. They competed well, and their results too, were just out of the placings. Justine & Superman were happy with their tests for a 6th in 2B, and lucky enough to come 2nd in 2D, obtaining Jackpot Runner up as well. Saturday night saw the trio off into town after making sure their equine partners were happily settled in their yards, and had a lovely social drink and meal with other competitors.



Sunday dawned another hot windy day. Margie again rode some beautiful tests and won the 3C, and were just out of the placings for 3E. Sir George didn't feel 100%, and Lauren wisely scratched that day, but stayed on to support her other MADEC members. Justine and Superman had another good day riding the 2C and 2E, and were happy with the tests, but were pipped at the post for placings.



Donvale ARC - Horse Trials



Our members, Judy Dixon riding Bella, Lauren Farrell riding Celebrity Jack (Chester) and Kerryn Gooding riding Bamborough Brandy Snap ventured to Yarra Glen for the Donvale ARC Horse Trials on the weekend of our last rally. All 3 rode in the Level 3 and after nice dressage tests were all just out of the placings, Lauren did a wonderful clear round in the showjumping, Kerryn 1 rail and Judy a couple of rails over a very uneven course on the side of a hill. All three combinations did fantastic clear rounds cross country to finish just out of the placings overall but were all thrilled with their great rides. The cross country course was fantastic, the event was well run, and it is one to put on your calendar for the future.



Riddells Creek Annual Dressage Jackpot



Mansfield and District Equestrian Club members and Dressage enthusiast's Justine Wedlock and Penelope Thomson travelled to Woodend on Sunday to compete at the Riddles Creek Annual Jackpot Dressage Day. Although warm temperature were forecast a good breeze made the day more pleasurable, the Woodend recreation reserve has a number of sand arenas available for competitors with a very strong field of nearly 80 competitors over the six grades from Level 5 to Advanced.

Justine riding Superman and Poss riding Kindara Clover entered their current levels and were permitted to compete one level above also. Both members took advantage of the chance to ride four Dressage tests in the one day and both were rewarded with some fantastic results. Due to the order of the running of the day the pair had to ride their higher tests first before their allocated graded tests. Justine and Superman were first up in the Level 1B with a brilliant 1st place and (62.31%) and the 1E and 5th giving the combination an overall 2nd in the Jackpot.

Justine and Superman competed in the level 2B with an 8th and the 2E and a 2nd (66.09%) place and an overall Jackpot place of 5th. Poss and Clover in the level 2B with 3rd (62.27%) and 2E and 8th place with an Overall Jackpot place of 6th.

Poss and Clover then competed in the Level 3B with two blinding scores of a 2nd (78.95%) and the 2E with (82.27%) and a combination overall result of 2nd in the Jackpot.

The competition year has really only just begun, these results are true testament to the tireless hours competitors put into their sport, as well as the time and commitment of travel to events.

Other Results

Two of our members went all the way to Pakenham for the EA and Pony Club Horse Trials on the 11th and 12th of February. Nic Bertalli riding Frisky Time rode in the Preliminary EA and did a lovely dressage test, had a rail in the showjumping and clear cross country to finish in 3rd place. Nikki Grey riding Smarty Class (Snippy) competed in the Grade 2 Pony Club and after a lovely dressage test, clear showjumping, and cross country placed 2nd. The cross country course was very challenging being on the side of an extremely steep hill and both girls handled it beautifully.

Dressage Workshop with Tamara Fox

You will be able to watch as an experienced horse and rider go through some dressage moves and then you will be able to use the skills learnt and try them out for yourself under the expert guidance of Tamara Fox.

It will be great to have the opportunity to watch a demo horse for people to see the differences in the collected, working, lengthening and extended paces and also lateral work
