8. General Business

- Rodeo
 - o 13 to 17yo ticket holders need to have a different coloured wrist band to 18+ ticket holders as there was no way to identify them as they came in and out once their tickets had been scanned This was especially an issue for cash sales at the gate where people sent someone to purchase tickets for later
 - Security do security separate to gate
 - It was busier earlier this year and it was too busy to do a hand over or should someone be there the whole time
 - o The app flicked up the ticket/VIP/drinks as well
 - o More than 2 Volunteers needed on the gates if the current ticketing system is to continue. 1 Volunteer cash only tickets, 2 Volunteers scanning and 1 to 2 Volunteers to put on wristbands. We may need to look at how we can subsidise members who Volunteer to try and get numbers up other than just free entry to Rodeo. This is something that we do every year with great financial benefit to the club and we have the same few members volunteering each year.
 - Layout too close to ATM, crowds to the back of the tents (need a back on Marqueees)
 - o No cash sales at gate
 - Needs starlink (not Telstra)
- Sand arena committee
 - After campdraft and horse trials, there will be a meeting to discuss future conditions
 - o Kirsten to request a copy of sand arena agreement
 - o Dog trails did they pay a user fee? Add to sand arena meeting.
 - Rates to be discussed at sand committee meeting
