Victoria's Showjumping

Top Teams Trophy

Mansfield and District Equestrian Club provided two teams to compete in the Horse Riding Club Association of Victoria's Showjumping Top Team's Trophy held in Shepparton at the W.S Hunter Reserve over the weekend of the 15th & 16th of September. This venue is purpose built for the Showjumping World Cup circuit and is a fabulous venue to ride on, catering for a range of equestrian sports perfectly. The event attracted over 350 riders which made up over 90 teams, from throughout Victoria and Southern New South Wales.

This event allows all members of HRCAV to compete against all levels of experience from Level 5 (least experienced) to Advanced (the most experienced). Teams of four are chosen from a variation of Levels within their club (or if entered individually then you are placed in a composite team), places of individuals are calculated within the team and this gives the final result of the Top Team's Trophy.

Mansfield Matrix consisted of Perrin Gooding riding Loreda Lad L3, Jane Parks riding Parkview Irish Lily L2, Anette Allan riding Gorserella Matilla L4 and Judy Dixon riding Bella L3. With an Overall team result of 21st place.
